- The Peterborough Woman's Club Scholarship was established to honor and recognize a high school senior girl from the ConVal School District for outstanding service to her school and community.
- One \$1500 scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient in June of the year she enters college.
- Applicants must be high school senior girls residing in the ConVal School District.
- **Of greatest importance in selecting a recipient is the applicant's record of service to individuals and organizations in her school and our community.**
- **The application deadline is Friday May 3, 2019.** All materials should be submitted to the guidance office at ConVal High School by the end of school on that date.
- **Application requirements:**
 - Peterborough Woman's Club scholarship application
 - Official high school transcript
 - Two letters of recommendation: one from a member of the local community who can comment on the applicant's record of service, and one from a teacher of an academic subject.
 - After the above materials are received, each applicant will receive notice by mail of her interview appointment with the scholarship committee. The ten minute interview will be held at ConVal during regular school hours.
- The scholarship committee's decision will be reached by late May. The recipient and her adult guest will be honored at the Peterborough Woman's Club annual meeting in mid-June.
